The artwork can be a painting, drawing, sculpture or any other piece made by a person with Prader-Willi syndrome.

The artwork will be formatted and displayed electronically for viewing on a big screen in the lecture halls before each of the sessions and during breaks. The title of the piece will be displayed on the screen together with the name, age and country of the artist.

The maximum number of submissions from each artist is 3 pieces. This is not a competition. Each artist will receive an electronic certificate with the conference logo thanking them for their submission.

For each submission, please send to me, Tiina Silvast, an e-mail with the name, age, and geographical address of the artist; the title of the piece; and a description of the artwork or medium used (e.g., water color, needle point, paint-by-number, clay, etc.).

Please attach a digital photo of the artwork in JPEG form, at least the size of 3 MB's. By submitting the artwork to the IPWSO Virtual Art Gallery, it is understood that it becomes the property of IPWSO, and it can be used for publication and for fund raising purposes.
